#### 2011 Kid's Market Rules:

1. Youth Vendors can only sell products that are handmade or homegrown and must be made or grown by the Youth Vendor with minimal help from an adult. No garage sale or flea market items will be permitted.
2. No baked goods allowed.
3. Absolutely no goods made by others are allowed to be resold.  
If artwork is being sold, the artwork must be original and use of licensed, trademarked, or copyrighted characters or names (such as team mascots, Disney, or animated characters, etc.) are prohibited.
4. A parent or guardian must sign the application.
5. The Youth Vendor is expected to staff their space, not an adult, though an adult may be present.
6. The youth is responsible for the selling of their goods and interactions with customers. Adults are not allowed to sell their child's products.
7. Youth Vendors shall conduct their business in a professional manner, and will be civil and respectful towards each other, staff, and customers at all times.
8. Dress and language should be appropriate for a market and community/family event.
9. Fair market prices are expected.
10. At the Kid's Market, Youth Vendors must accurately record their sales on their 'Sales Report Form' and return the completed form to Downtown Fremont, Inc. who will pay the sales tax on behalf of the Youth Vendor. If this form is not completed and returned at the end of the Kid's Market, the Youth Vendor will be responsible for submitting all sales tax to the State of Ohio.

#### Space Information:

1. Each Youth Vendor's space is limited to a 4-person card table. If additional space is preferred, special permission must be granted in advance. No tents are provided.
2. Youth Vendors must provide a table, chair, and/or any other material necessary for their display.
3. Set-up and tear down time should only take one hour with or without adult help.
4. Youth Vendor's space location will be assigned the week of the event after registration is completed and received.
5. Electricity will not be available.

2. Registrations must be postmarked or delivered by hand by 7:00 p.m. on September 22, 2011.
